



## **Rules & Camp Code of Conduct**

**At Superior English Experience we strive to have all campers and staff exhibit common sense to help create a positive and safe environment of adventure and education!**

1. Campers are required to obey all federal, provincial and municipal laws and by-laws. Failure to do so can result in dismissal from camp.
2. No alcohol or drug use is permitted at any time during camp or anywhere campers participate in activities. Zero tolerance policy
3. No smoking is permitted by Campers or staff at any time during the camp program. Zero tolerance policy.
4. Anyone caught with drugs, alcohol, cigarettes, or anyone caught bullying or exhibiting inappropriate behaviour will be immediately dismissed from the program with no compensation. Zero tolerance policy.
5. Prescription medication is allowed with written notification from parent / guardian and provided the camper is able to administer it themselves or with minimal assistance.
6. In order to ensure the safety of your child, Campers must stay with staff at all times. No Campers are allowed to come and go unsupervised.
7. Parents / guardians are asked not to visit their children while they are participating in camp activities. We want your child to stay focused on learning the language and in the sporting events, while making friends! You will be given contact information if you need to reach your child in case of an emergency.
8. Campers will make every reasonable effort to use the Spanish language when participating in camp activities. Practicing at home helps too!
9. In the spirit of co-operation, Campers and staff will work together, assisting each other whenever possible.
10. All Campers and staff will respect each others rights, property and opinions.
11. At Superior English Experience we want Campers to make friends, but we prohibit any romantic involvement during camp.
12. All Campers and staff will try their hardest to have fun!

# Terms & Conditions

“Camp” from herein refers to Superior English Experience, its Directors, officers, employees, staff and other agents.

1. We regret we cannot accept verbal registrations. A registration package, completed in full and signed by parent / guardian, must be accompanied by payment in full.
2. Registration may be cancelled with refund of fees (less \$50 per camper for administrative costs) up to fourteen days prior to the session affected. Cancellations inside of fourteen days will result in complete forfeiture of fees. All financial obligations of the camp are fixed for the season and the withdrawal of a camper does not lessen operating expenses.
3. All cancellations must be communicated in writing.
4. Camp reserves the right to dismiss a camper from camp if any of the rules and regulations are violated. One warning will be given to parents. No refunds will be given under any circumstance for the dismissal or withdrawal of a camper.
5. Camp will not be held responsible for lost, damaged or stolen belongings. Campers should not bring valuables to camp.
6. Enrollment in camp includes your consent to your child’s photo and name being used for any Camp purpose including publicity.
7. Camp shall not be held responsible and is hereby released from any liability for any sickness, accident or injury to your child.
8. By signing below, you confirm that you are the legal guardian of the camper you are registering.
9. By signing below you confirm that your child is capable of participating safely in the full camp program, unless you advise to the contrary in advance.
10. By signing below you acknowledge that attendance and participation at Camp involves risks and hazards incidental thereto, all of which are assumed by you.
11. By signing below you hereby waive, release, absolve and agree to indemnify and save harmless Superior English Experience, its respective officers, directors, employees, staff and agents of any and all liability arising from your child’s attendance and participation in the Camp program.
12. By signing below you acknowledge that your child’s attendance at Camp and your relationship with Camp shall be governed by the laws of the Province of Ontario and you shall submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of the Province of Ontario in that regard.
